



UpSlide Consistency Challenge – Terms & Conditions

1. Promoter

The promoter is **UpSlide SAS**, a French company registered at 20, avenue de l'Opéra – 75001 Paris, represented by Julien Villemonteix (hereinafter, the "**Promoter**").

2. Promotion

These Terms & Conditions (the "**Rules**") govern the UpSlide Consistency Challenge (the "**Promotion**"), a free prize draw with no obligation to purchase.

3. Eligibility

The Promotion is open to individuals who, at the time of entry:

- Are aged **18 years or over**;
- Are employed by an organization operating in the financial services sector (including banking, investment management, insurance, fintech);
- Enter using a **valid business email address** associated with their employer (Entries submitted using personal or non-business email addresses (including but not limited to Gmail, Yahoo, Outlook, or similar domains) will not be eligible).

The Promotion is open worldwide **except where prohibited or restricted by local law**.

Important for US residents: This Promotion is a sweepstakes. No purchase necessary. Void where prohibited. See article 13 for additional provision applicable to US Residents.

Employees of UpSlide, its group companies, agents, or anyone professionally connected with the Promotion, as well as their immediate family members, are not eligible to participate.

The Promoter reserves the right to verify eligibility by checking:

- Business email domain against known financial services organisations;
- LinkedIn profile or other publicly available professional information;
- Direct confirmation request to the participant's employer (if necessary).

The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any participant who does not meet these criteria or who provides false or misleading information.

4. Promotion Period

The Promotion opens at **00:00 (GMT) on 17/02/2026 and closes at 23:59 (GMT) on 31/03/2026** (the "**Promotion Period**").

Entries received outside the Promotion Period will not be eligible.

5. How to Enter

No purchase is necessary to enter.

To enter the Promotion, eligible participants must:

- Access the UpSlide Consistency Challenge at <https://upslide.com/consistency-challenge/>;
- Complete the Promotion; and
- Submit the entry form with the following details:
 - full name;
 - valid professional email address;
 - employer name;
 - job title

Only one entry per person is permitted. Multiple entries from the same person or entries submitted on behalf of others will be disqualified.

By submitting an entry, you:

- accept these Rules;
 - consent to the processing of your personal data as described in Article 9 below;
 - confirm that the information provided is accurate and that you meet the eligibility requirements.
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6. The Game

The Promotion involves reviewing a set of presentation slides and identifying inconsistencies.

Participants will be shown a score and completion time. Any score, timing, or comparison with UpSlide's AI Consistency Check feature is provided **for demonstration and illustrative purposes only**.

Your performance in the game, including score and completion time, **does not affect the chances of winning**. The winner will be selected at random from all eligible entries.

7. Prize

One (1) winner will receive:

Two (2) tickets to attend a Formula 1 Grand Prix race, subject to availability, with an approximate value of 2.500 € depending on the race and seating category (the "**Prize**").

The Prize details:

- the specific race, circuit, date and seating category will be determined by the Promoter in consultation with the winner, subject to availability at the time of booking;



- possible race locations include (subject to availability): Monaco, Silverstone, Spa-Francorchamps, Monza , Austin, Miami, Singapore and other circuits on the official Formula calendar;
- the Prize includes tickets only and does not include: travel, accommodation, meals, transfers, insurance, visa costs or any other expenses;
- the Prize is non-transferable
- there is no cash alternative

The winner is solely responsible for any taxes, duties or charges arising from acceptance or use of the Prize under the laws of their country of residence.

For US residents: the approximate retail value of the Prize may be reported to tax authorities as required by law. Winners may be required to complete IRS Form W-0 or equivalent tax documentation.

UpSlide reserves the right to substitute the Prize with one of equal or greater value if circumstances beyond its control require it (including but not limited to ace cancellation, ticket unavailability, or force majeure).

8. Winner Selection and Notification

8.1. Selection

The winner (the “**Winner**”) will be selected **at random** from all eligible entries received during the Promotion Period.

The random draw will take place within **7 days** of the Promotion Period ending.

8.2. Notification

The Winner will be notified using the contact details provided at entry within 7 calendar days of the draw. The Winner must respond within 14 calendar days of the notification email to claim the Prize. The response must confirm:

- Acceptance of the Prize;
- Confirmation of eligibility;
- Any additional information reasonably required by the promoter (e.g. proof of age, proof of employment in financial services sector if requested).

8.3. Unclaimed Prize

If the Winner:

- does not respond within **14 calendar days** of notification, or
- decline the Prize; or
- is found to be ineligible

The Promoter reserves the right to select an alternative Winner at random from the remaining eligible entries. This process may be repeated

8.4. Publicity

By accepting the Prize, the Winner consents to the Promoter announcing the Winner's first name and country of residence on UpSlide's website and social media channels.

The Winner may refuse such publicity by notifying the Promoter in writing within 7 calendar days of accepting the Prize, except where disclosure is required by law.

9. Data Protection

9.1. Data Controller

UpSlide SAS acts as data controller for the personal data collected through this Promotion.

9.2. Data collected

The Promoter collects and processes the following personal data:

- name;
- email address;
- country of residence;
- employer's name;
- entry timestamp and game performance data (for fraud prevention purposes only).

9.3. Purposes of Processing

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

- (i) contest administration (on the legal basis of performance of contract): verifying eligibility, conduct the random draw, contacting the Winner, delivering the Prize;
- (ii) fraud prevention (legitimate interest): detecting multiple entries from the same person, preventing automated or fraudulent entries;
- (iii) marketing communications (consent): if you tick the separate opt-in checkbox on the entry form, UpSlide may send you marketing emails about its products and services. You may withdraw consent at any time by clicking "unsubscribe" in any marketing email or contacting marketing@upslide.com.

9.4. Data Retention

Non-Winners: personal data will be deleted 6 months after the Promotion Period ends.

Winner: personal data will be retained for 3 years for legal, accounting and tax purposes.

Marketing opt-ins: Data will be retained until you withdraw consent or for X years of inactivity, whichever comes first.

9.5. Data Sharing

Your personal data may be shared with:

- Salesforce (CRM platform) for storage and management of entries;
- Third-party service providers assisting with Prize delivery (eg ticket vendors, travel agencies);
- Legal or regulatory authorities if required by applicable law.

9.6. International Data Transfers

Personal data may be transferred to and processed in countries outside the European Economic Area, including the United States. Such transfers are protected by the United States. Such transfers are protected by appropriate safeguards, including Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission.

9.7. Your rights

Under applicable data protection laws (including the EU General Data Protection Regulation), you have the right to:

- Access your personal data;
- Rectify inaccurate data;
- Request erasure (except where retention is legally required);
- Object to processing or restrict processing;
- Data portability;
- Lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (CNIL in France, or your local data protection authority).

10. Fraud, Abuse, and Disqualification

UpSlide reserves the right to disqualify any participant if it has reasonable grounds to believe that the participant has:

- Provided false, incomplete or misleading information
- Used automated systems, bots, scripts or any technical means to gain an unfair advantage;
- Submitted multiple entries or entries on behalf of others
- Manipulated or attempted to manipulate the entry process or the Promotion
- Acted in breach of these Terms & Conditions or in any manner that is fraudulent, dishonest or harmful to the Promoter or other participants.

The Promoter reserves the right to report suspected fraudulent activity to relevant authorities

Any disqualified entry will not be eligible for the Prize, and no correspondence will be entered into

11. Limitation of Liability

11.1. Technical Issues

The Promoter shall not be responsible for:

- Technical failures, system errors, server outages or network issues that prevent or delay entry;
- Incomplete, corrupted, delayed, or lost entries due to technical problems beyond the Promoter's reasonable control;
- Entries that are not received for any reason

Proof of transmission (eg screenshot of submission) is not proof of receipt by the Promoter.

11.2. Force Majeure

The Promoter shall not be liable for any failure to perform its obligations under these Rules where such failure is caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to: acts of gods, natural disasters, pandemics, epidemics, war, terrorism, civil unrest, riots, changes to Formula 1 race schedules, cancellations, postponements or relocations, government restrictions, changes in law or regulatory requirements, strikes, labour disputes, or industrial action.

In such circumstances, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel the Promotion, amend the Prize or substitute it with one of equivalent value.

11.3. Use of the Prize

The Winner assumes all risk and liability in connection with acceptance, possession and use of the Prize, including but not limited to:

- travel to and attendance at the Formula 1 race;
- Personal injury, property damage or loss;
- Compliance with race venue rules, regulations and security requirements,
- Obtaining necessary travel documents (passport, visa, health certificates).

The Promoter strongly recommends that the Winner obtains appropriate travel and health insurance.

11.4. Maximum liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Promoter's maximum aggregate liability arising from or in connection with this Promotion (whether in contract, tort, negligence or otherwise) shall not exceed the approximate retail value of the Prize (2.500 €).

Nothing in these Rules excludes or limits liability for: death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation, any other liability that cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law.

12. Formula 1 Trademark Disclaimer

Formula 1, F1, FORMULA ONE, and related trademarks logos and trade dress are the property of Formula One Licensing BV a formula 1 company.



This Promotion is not affiliated with, endorsed by, sponsored by, administered by, or otherwise associated with Formula One Licensing BV Formula 1, the FIA (fédération internationale de l'automobile) or any Formula 1 teams, circuits, or sponsors.

All Formula 1-related trademarks, logos and imagery are used for descriptive purposes only to identify the nature of the Prize.

13. General

13.1 General governing law

These Rules are governed by the laws of France.

Subject to the mandatory local laws described below, any disputes arising from or in connection with the Promotion shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Paris, France.

13.2. Mandatory local laws

This promotion is subject to all applicable local, state and national laws and regulations in your country of residence.

If you are a resident of a country whose laws: prohibit or restrict prize promotions, sweepstakes or contests; or provide mandatory consumer protections that cannot be waived or; prohibit the application of foreign law or jurisdiction.

Then those mandatory provisions shall prevail to the extent required by law and these Rules shall be interpreted consistently such mandatory provisions.

UpSlide reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or amend the Promotion or these Terms & Conditions where necessary due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

For French residents qualifying as consumers under French law, any dispute may be submitted free of charge to a consumer mediation body in accordance with the French Consumer Code.

13.3. Special Provisions for US Residents

For participants residing in the United States:

(a) Sweepstakes Nature

This Promotion is a sweepstakes. No purchase or payment of any kind is necessary to enter or win. A purchase will not improve your chances of winning.

(b) Void Where Prohibited

This sweepstakes is void where prohibited or restricted by law.

(c) Eligibility Verification

Winners may be required to sign and return an Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability Release, and (where legal) Publicity Release within 14 days of notification. Failure to return these documents within the required timeframe may result in disqualification and selection of an alternative winner.



(d) Tax Reporting

If the approximate retail value of the Prize exceeds \$600 USD, UpSlide may be required to report the Prize value to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). Winners may be required to complete IRS Form W-9 and may receive IRS Form 1099-MISC for tax reporting purposes. The winner is solely responsible for any federal, state, or local taxes on the Prize.

(e) Disputes

Any disputes, claims, or causes of action arising from this Promotion (except where prohibited by law) shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action. To the extent permitted by law, participants waive any right to claim punitive, exemplary, or multiplied damages.

(f) State-Specific Requirements

14. Important Disclaimers

14.1. "Void Where Prohibited"

By entering this Promotion, you represent and warrant that your participation is lawful under the laws of your country, state, or province of residence.

If you are a resident of a jurisdiction where this type of promotion is prohibited or restricted by law, **you may not enter**, and any entry from such jurisdiction will be void.

14.2. No Guarantee of Prize Availability

While the Promoter will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the Winner's preferences for race location, dates, and seating, **the specific race and seating category cannot be guaranteed** and will depend on availability at the time of booking (typically 2-8 weeks after winner confirmation).

The Promoter is not responsible for sold-out races, schedule changes, or unavailability of preferred options.

14.3. Race Attendance Conditions

Attendance at the Formula 1 race is subject to:

- The race taking place as scheduled (races may be cancelled, postponed, rescheduled, or relocated by Formula 1 or race organisers)
- The Winner complying with venue rules, security requirements, health and safety protocols, and applicable laws
- The Winner having valid travel documents (passport, visa if required, health certificates if required)
- The Winner meeting any age, health, or other requirements imposed by the race venue or local authorities

The Promoter has no control over and is not responsible for any decisions made by Formula 1, race organisers, or local authorities.

14.4. Independent Promotion

This Promotion is an independent marketing initiative by UpSlide SAS. It is not part of any official Formula 1 promotion, sponsorship, or partnership.

15. General

15.1. Amendment or Cancellation

The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, suspend, modify, or extend the Promotion or amend these Rules at any time if circumstances beyond its reasonable control make it necessary, if required by law or regulatory authority, or if the integrity of the Promotion is compromised.

Any material changes will be communicated via the Promotion website at <https://upslide.com/consistency-challenge/> or by email to participants where reasonably practicable.

15.2. Severability

If any provision of these Rules is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court or regulatory authority, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect to the maximum extent permitted by law.

15.3. Interpretation

These Rules are drafted in English. In the event of any discrepancy between the English version and any translation, the English version shall prevail.

Headings are for convenience only and do not affect the interpretation of these Rules.

15.4. Entire Agreement

These Rules, together with UpSlide's Privacy Policy (<https://upslide.com/data-privacy-policy/>) constitute the entire agreement between the participant and the Promoter in relation to the Promotion and supersede any prior representations, agreements, or understandings.



15.5. No Assignment

Participants may not assign, transfer, or delegate any rights or obligations under these Rules. The Promoter may assign its rights and obligations to any third party without notice.

15.6. Waiver

No failure or delay by the Promoter in exercising any right under these Rules shall operate as a waiver of that right. A waiver of any breach shall not constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach.

16. Winner Announcement

Following verification of eligibility and acceptance of the Prize, the Winner's first name and country of residence may be made available upon written request for a period of **3 months** following the close of the Promotion Period, in accordance with applicable data protection laws.
